Replacement of Filter

To remove the filter, loosen or remove hose clamp at filter, remove hose from filter assembly. Remove assembly, replace filter element or filter assembly.

Inspect hoses for cracks, rubber separation, or slivers of rubber in the inside diameter of hose. Replace hose if cracks or separation is observed. Slivers can and do break off, if they get ingested in pump, premature failure can occur. Hose clamps or fittings should be replaced when broken, damaged or corroded.

CAUTION

Never apply compressed air to line or components installed on the aircraft. Excessive air pressure will damage the gyro instruments. Disconnect lines at both ends and blow from the instrument panel out
